Purpose: formation of basic knowledge of the theory and practice of financial relations between economic entities, development of financial resources, financial planning, financial performance of companies.

Objective: To study the nature and functions of enterprise finance, financial resources and sources of their formation, organization of enterprise finance; to acquire the skills of financial calculations, to master the techniques of financial planning, financial condition assessment and rehabilitation of enterprises.

Subject: system of financial and economic relations that arise in the course of current and investment activity of economic entities.

Content of the subject is revealed in the topics: Principles of enterprise finance. Organization of monetary transactions between companies. Earnings of enterprises. Formation and distribution of profits. Taxation of enterprises. Working capital. Enterprise lending. Financial support for reproduction of fixed assets. Evaluation of the financial situation of enterprises. Financial planning on enterprises. Financial reorganization of enterprises.

Supporting lectures and practical classes: computer, multimedia equipment, didactic materials.

Assessment: written test, performance of individual tasks, test, lecture and practical modules, examination.

Teaching methods: interactive (thought-provoking) lectures, role plays, case-studies, business simulations.
