**Purpose:** mastering basic knowledge of the theory and practice of financial, economic, organizational and legal relations in the mortgage market including domestic and foreign experience, based on the laws and regulations of Ukraine.

**Objective:** familiarize students with the content of mortgage operations and train them to use the information received to organize the major areas of banking activity in the mortgage market.

**Subject:** Organization of mortgage lending.

**Content of the subject is revealed in the topics:** Mortgage market: general characteristics, subjects and objects. Mortgage market infrastructure. Selection and characterization of the sources of mortgage market financing. The essence of the mortgage, its types and models of repaying mortgage debt. Risks in mortgage lending and management. Mortgage housing market in Ukraine. Mortgages for consumer and commercial property. Youth mortgage programs. Government financing of purchase (construction) of housing. Mortgage securities. Specific features of mortgage assets securitization. Land market in Ukraine as a basis for the development of mortgage lending. Specific features of investing in real estate. Capitalization of income from real estate. Basics of mortgage and investment analysis.
