Purpose: to create conditions and provide opportunities for students to understand the basic concepts and categories of SNA, which is the basis of economic statistics and evaluation of the general laws of formation, functioning and development of the economy; to develop and consolidate skills of using SNA data which were approved in practice.

Objective: to familiarize students with the basic categories, principles and parameters of SNA, which is a system of economic information and is used worldwide to describe and analyze the economic process at the macro level.

Subject: current international standard for international organizations in the field of national accounting, which is an important component of economic statistics and the statistics used by the majority of countries with market economies.

Content of the subject is revealed in the topics: Sources of and stages of SNA. Overview of SNA. Classification and categories. Current accounts. Savings accounts. Balances. Transaction accounts and balance with "other world". Units in the SNA. Using SNA data in macroeconomic analysis and modeling.

Supporting lectures and practical classes: computer, multimedia equipment, didactic materials.

Assessment: written test, performance of individual tasks, test, lecture and practical modules, examination.

Teaching methods: interactive (thought-provoking) lectures, role plays, case studies, business simulations.

Instructional support: reference compendium of lectures, teaching materials, control tests.
