Purpose: formation of knowledge on methodology and practical implementation of financial reorganization, bankruptcy, financial support of liquidation procedures.

Objective: To study the nature, methods, rules and mechanisms for financial reorganization, bankruptcy and liquidation, as well as forms and methods of state financial support for rehabilitation entities; to master skills in pre-trial rehabilitation and understand complex issues related to company reorganization in legal form and reorganization restructuring of business entities.

Subject: financial and economic relations arising in the process of financial reorganization, restructuring, bankruptcy and liquidation of economic entities.

Content of the subject is revealed in the topics: Basics of crisis management of company finance. Diagnosis of the financial crisis in the enterprise. Controlling of crisis management. Reorganization audit. Forms and prerequisites of financing anti-crisis measures. Internal sources of financial reorganization of the enterprise. External sources of financial reorganization of the enterprise. Restructuring and reorganization. Valuation of company property. Economic and legal aspects of reorganization and bankruptcy. Features of reorganization and bankruptcy of certain categories of businesses. State financial support for company rehabilitation.
