Purpose: theoretical and practical knowledge of the foundations of the functioning and development of financial market as a subsystem of financial relations.

Objective: To explore the nature and importance of financial markets in the sphere of economic relations, relationship between sources of funds and their use, functioning of financial instruments, essence of financial intermediation, specific features of different types of financial instruments, types, forms and methods of financial market regulation.

Subject: relations arising in the process of buying and selling financial resources and organizing separate segments of the financial market.

Content of the subject is revealed in the topics: Financial Markets: nature, function and role in the economy. Regulation of financial markets. Financial intermediaries. Interest rates and their structure. The risk and cost of capital. Bond market as part of the capital market. Market of equity securities. Market of derivatives. Money market and the market of bank loans. Forex (currency) market. Stock exchange and stock transactions. Fundamental and technical analysis.

Supporting lectures and practical classes: computer, multimedia equipment, didactic materials.

Assessment: written test, performance of individual tasks, test, lecture and practical modules, examination.

Teaching methods: interactive (thought-provoking) lectures, role plays, case-studies, business simulations
